- 7) Regardless if chili runs out, contestants must stay until contest winners are announced. (approximately 8:30 pm)
- 8) Contestant can sample other entries, at no charge.
- 9) Each contestant can bring one guest at no charge; additional guests must pay \$7.00 admission fee.
- 10) We encourage you to have fun, be creative and decorate your 'space'.
- 11) Chefs may each enter one Chili, unless space becomes available for additional entries.
